Palermo

This day is dedicated to discover Palermo, a city that lies on a natural amphitheater, with the Pellegrino hill on the West and the gulf on the East. The town has incredible characteristics, not just for its location but also for its atmosphere of both Arabian and Norman styles, with its splendid boulevards and elegant buildings. We will drive by the main elegant boulevard of the city, "Via Libertà", and pass along Politeama and Massimo Theatres located in magnificent squares in the shopping and residence quarters. Our first stop will be to admire "La Martorana", founded in 1143 by George of Antioch, King Roger's Syrian emir and admiral. Although raised in the Orthodox faith, the Emir planned La Martorana as a mosque. Now the church is a mixing of Baroque Greek Byzantine style. Just behind this religious building lies "Piazza Pretoria", the most important city's square where is located the imposing Gothic style city-hall. Our next stop will be in Piazza Marina, which was a swamp until drained by the Arabians and used as their first citadel. Since then, the square witnessed the shame and glory of Palermo: in one side, the imposing Catalan-Gothic Fortress, in the opposite side, the elegant Mirto's Palace, that we will visit and feel the private life of one of the most important noble family of Sicily. A brief walk throughout the Vucciria market area will get you in touch with the most local Palermo. In the afternoon we will admire the Cappuccini Convent and its grim catacombs where, in macabre Sicilian style, the bodies of important people were mummified from the 16th century to 1881. In these galleries, embalmers have stored over 8,000 mummies. The tour will proceed to Monreale, to admire the imposing Norman Cathedral, founded in 1172 by Guglielmo II. Inside of it there is an unforgettable sight of 6,000 square meters of shining mosaics depicting Old and New Testament.

Excursion to Segesta, a fantastic complex of Greek ruins. Segesta was founded by Elymni, a people whose language has yet to be transcribed. The settlers claimed to be refugees who escaped the Fall of Troy, but some scholars believe them to be an iconoclastic tribe of Iberian-Ligurian descent. Segesta itself was sacked by Siracusa in 307 BC.

After the visit, reach Trapani for a short walk throughout the salinas, which have been the true reason of development of all this area until recent times.

Close to Trapani you will visit Erice, a village surrounded by the ancient walls, that preserves a characteristic medieval atmosphere. From there you will have a spectacular view of the Egadi islands.



MARSALA & MOZIA

Today the itinerary will be a combination of culture, history and food. We will take you to Mozia, once one of the most important Phoenician colonies. Then we will have a short walk throughout the salinas, which have been the true reason of development of all this area until recent times. Continue the tour to the area of Marsala, where most of the Sicilian wines are from: we will visit one of the most important wineries, to get the notions of how wine is made. Nowadays Sicilian wines are known for their very high quality.

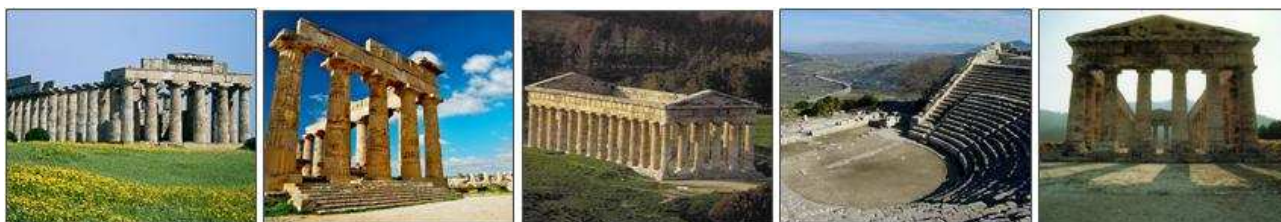

SELINUNTE

Our itinerary will take you back in history: visit the complex of ruins in Selinunte, founded by the Trojans escaping their war with the Greeks.



Planeta is not just one wine but many wines. It is also a journey through Sicily from the province of Agrigento in the west starting from Sambuca di Sicilia and Menfi, towards the south-east through the provinces of Ragusa and Siracusa, and then heading north-east to Etna in the province of Catania. Today there are 115 hectares at Dispensa alone. The estate is still the focus of new experiments and is well worth a visit for the arresting sight of 1,500 barriques where the wine is maturing. Further south in the province of Ragusa lies the Dorilli estate, near Vittoria. This estate, with 28 hectares already planted, produces Planeta's Cerasuolo di Vittoria, the first D.O.C.G. to be produced by the firm. The old farmhouse forms the background to the new winery. The soil is sandy, red and demonstrates variations of heat which favour the grapes.

AGRIGENTO

You will visit the spectacular Temples Valley, the most imposing example of Grecian temples, which includes the famous Temple of Concord, dating from the 5th century BC.



Proceed to Piazza Armerina for the visit of the Roman Villa of Casale: this villa, because of the magnificence of its polychrome mosaics and their excellent condition, represents the most important

document of Roman civilization in Sicily. The marvelous ruins comprises more than 40 rooms, artistically paved with mosaics.

Ragusa and Modica

The village of Modica is a complex multi-level town, with its tiers of sumptuous churches and shabby palaces stacked upon the hill; in this small village, you will breath the real atmosphere of Sicily. Walk around in Ibla, the old part of Ragusa, built in Baroque style and recreated on a medieval street plan, with its secret shrines, family crests and baroque fountains. Ibla is known for its typical oriel windows, showy staircases, tawny-colored mansions and filigree balconies, secret arches and yellowing palm trees.



As excellent alternative, feel free to consider Caltagirone, a surprising array of colors taking form in objects made of terracotta, and the tradition of ceramics is visible everywhere in the city.

Noto and Siracuse

Today you will explore the part of the island washed from the Ionian Sea. You will stop in Noto, with its Baroque style cathedral and its imposing palaces: the architectural details of this village are fascinating, from the doors of an ordinary house to the balconies of a patrician palace.
Next stop will be Siracusa, built on an ancient Greek settlement founded by Corinthians. More than any other modern city in Sicily, Siracusa manifests a visible continuity from its ancient Greek past, both historical and mythological. Its older quarter is an island, Ortygia, which was the most important city in Magna Graecia, and for a time rivalled Athens as the most important city of the Greek world.
